CODE OF CONDUCT 2015

The aim of Barnard Castle & Teesdale Riding Club is to provide an enjoyable, friendly and safe environment for riding and riding related activities for all our members and their families and we ask all our members and parents/guardians to follow this code of conduct.

As a Senior member, Non riding member, a Junior member or as a parent/guardian on behalf of a junior member of BCTRC I agree to:

1. remember we all ride and compete for FUN
2. always ride and compete to the best of my ability
3. applaud effort and good play
4. respect my horse/pony and the horses/ponies of others
5. listen and respond to the instructor, without interfering, arguing or complaining
(see no.12)
6. compete fairly, without cheating, complaining or time wasting
7. always respect and avoid criticising instructors, officials, judges, stewards and other riders, both on my team and on other teams (see no.12)
8. always abide by the rules and decisions of the officials, stewards and judges (see no.12)
9. never engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
10. respect any other rules and code of conducts specific to an activity and venue (eg. Area 2)
11. never enter an arena or warm-up arena without the permission of the instructor, official, steward or judge
12. discuss with a BCTRC committee member if I am unhappy with anything about the club, or the behaviour of other club members.

I also agree to abide by the disciplinary procedure, if I am required to, by:

1. apologising to my fellow riders, team members, other team members, instructors, judges, stewards and officials as required
2. receiving a formal verbal warning from a member of the BCTRC club Committee
3. leaving the training or competition venue
4. receiving a formal written warning from the Chairperson of the BCTRC club Committee (by committee decision)
5. suspending all further attendance at club, Area 2 and national activities and attending a meeting with the Chairperson of the BCTRC club (by committee decision)
6. leaving the club, along with any dependants (by committee decision).
7. **understand that I represent BCTRC at all times when attending all club activities, Area 2 activities and National Level activities, whether I am a rider, spectator or helper.**
